Application Procedure	1. The email containing detailed information and link will be sent in late March for fall semester and late September for spring semester 2. Konkuk University does not facilitate off-campus housing.
Mandatory 14-day Quarantine	Starting from 1 April 2020, the Korean government has implemented mandatory quarantine to all travelers entering Korea from abroad. Several quarantining options exist (on-campus dormitory, Airbnb, government supervised facility, etc.) and the cost can range from USD 1,200~2,000 for the 14-day quarantine including meals.
Living Costs	USD 400~600 / month (varies depending upon the lifestyle of students)
Visa	All exchange students must obtain a D-2-6 (exchange student) visa in order to study at Konkuk University. Upon admission, students will receive the 'Certificate of Admission' which is required to apply for the visa. Students should contact the Korean consulate in their home countries for details.
Medical Insurance	All exchange students must purchase overseas health insurance which covers their study period prior to coming to Korea & enrol in the Korean National Health Insurance after arriving in Korea.
Facilities	University hospital, library, computer rooms, on-campus dormitory, cafeterias, adjacent subway (metro) system, adjacent shopping malls, etc.
