Exchange Program



250 courses taught in English.

Learning Agreement – between 20 and 30 ECTS credits (unless the Home University decides otherwise).

At the time of application, courses should be chosen from one faculty only. Courses from any other field of study can be added upon arrival at CUT, providing that you meet the prerequisites.

Academic Calendar

The academic year in Poland is divided into two semesters.

Fall Semester

From 1st of October until mid-February.

The examination session usually lasts for two or three weeks.

Spring Semester

from last Monday of February until 30th of June.

The examination session lasts around two-three weeks.

Summer holidays last three months – from the beginning of July to the end of September.



Student Housing

Accommodation in twin rooms with shared bathrooms and kitchen.

Costs PLN 460* (ca. EUR 100) per month. Student Housing Complex offer more economic option of accommodation, but the places are limited and it is necessary to book them in advance.

Places are allocated on a first- register basis.

Applications during the time of online registration for the exchange program.

Cost of Living



Currency: Polish Złoty (PLN).

Low costs of living.

Monthly expenses (average value):

Accommodation: PLN 460 (in CUT dormitory); PLN 800 - 2000 + utility bills (accommodation - own arrangement)

Food: from PLN 700

Transport: around PLN 80 (monthly pass with a student discount)

Mobile telephone pre-paid card - from PLN 30

Miscellaneous: PLN 300 – 500

Total: from around PLN 1500 (ca. EUR 330)*.

Students (upon showing their ID card) are entitled to discount prices on transportation fares and in the entertaining sector (e.g. museums, galleries, clubs, concerts).

Student volunteers from Cracow University of Technology who help International students to settle down and integrate with us here in Poland.

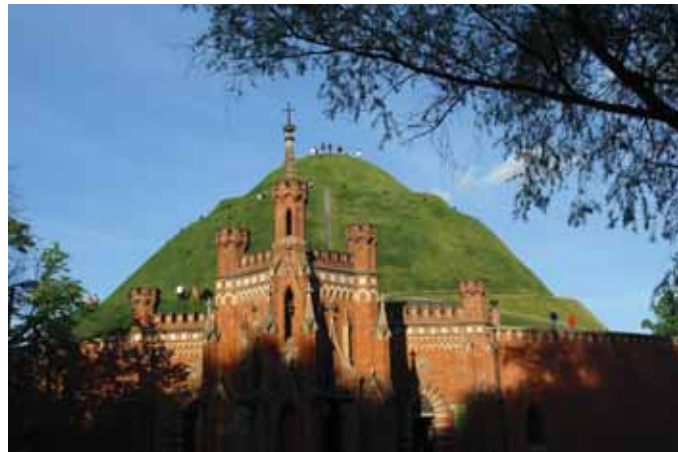
Krakow
