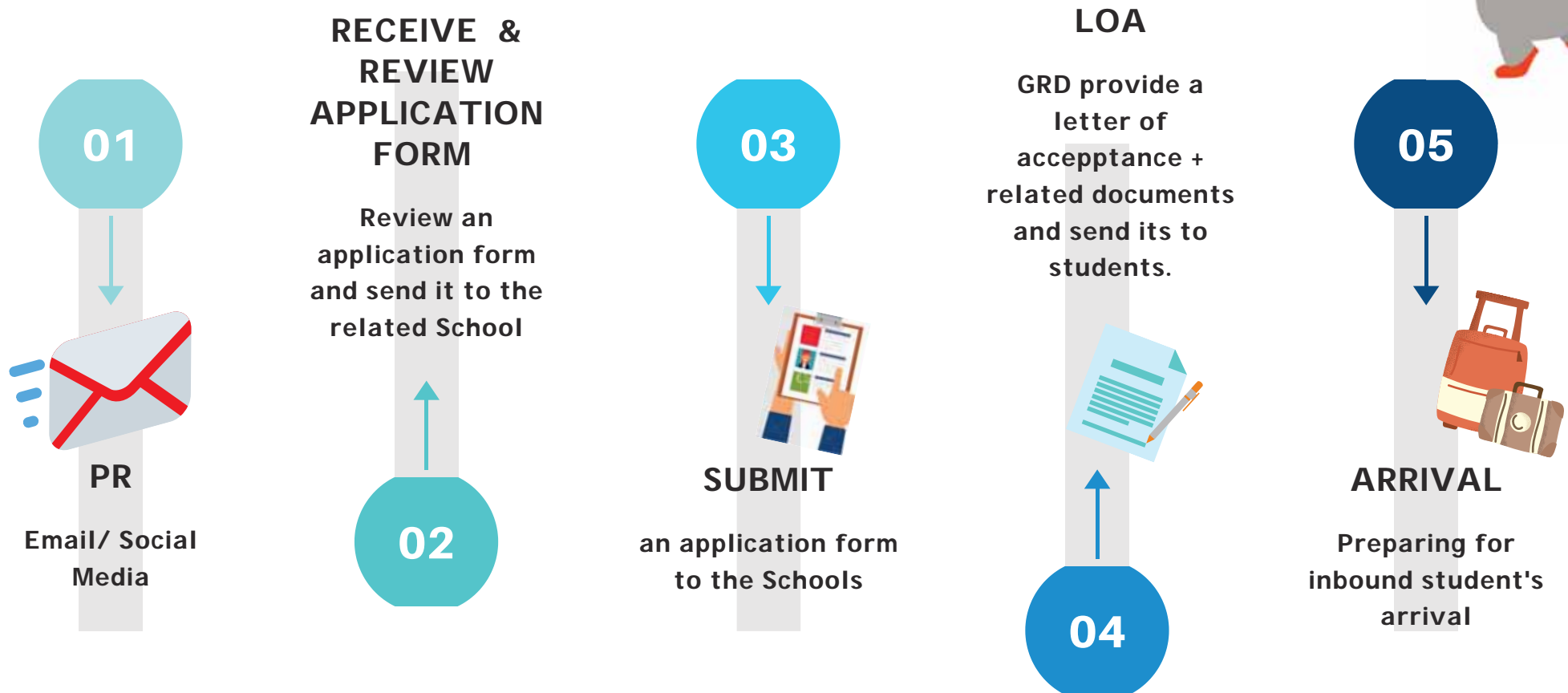

Guidelines for Travelers with exemption from quarantine

A Tips for **MFU** Incoming Exchange Students!



Before Travelling

- 1 You must be in the listed countries* more than 21 days

*Listed countries, please scan QR Code



- 2 Contact Thai embassy or Thai Consulate-General office for
2.1 Apply for the Non-Immigrant Visa Type "ED"

2.2 Apply for COE or Register Thailand Pass via <https://tp.consular.go.th/> with documents as follows:

1. Passport
2. Vaccination Certificate
3. COVID-19 Health Insurance with minimum coverage of USD 50,000

*You will get the form T8 from the system after registration

First airport of arrival in Thailand

- 1 Body temperature screening
- 2 Present mandatory documents
 1. Certificate of Entry or QR Code from Thailand Pass
 2. Vaccination Certificate
 3. COVID-19 Health Insurance with minimum coverage of USD 50,000
 4. RT-PCR test result within 72 hours
 5. SHA+/AQ Hotel Reservation

- 3 Proceed thru immigration screening baggage claims and customs clearance

- 4 Go to assembly point and take the bus to SHA+/AQ Hotel*

*Note: Must wait for RT-PCR test result at the hotel for 1 night or until receive negative result



At SHA+/AQ Hotel

- 1 Ensure "MoreChana" has been installed
- 2 RT-PCR Test and may stay until the result is available in SHA+/AQ Hotel
- 3 If COVID-19 tested negative, can leave the hotel/ If positive, proceed thru the treatment
- 4 Receive ATK test kit, and test on the 6th/7th day or when having symptoms

*Note: Traveler may be tested for COVID-19 after baggage claims in Phuket International Airport. However the test result will be collected at the hotel.



Before Travelling to MFU

- 1 Fill in the Arrival Form before traveling to MFU (at least 3 days in advance) via shorturl.at/iDNZ4



- 2 The Global Relations Division (GRD) provide a **free pick-up service** from the airport to MFU.

- 3 Complete the daily self-screening for 7 days at <https://bit.ly/3lResZF>



- 4 Follow the Universal Prevention for COVID-19
