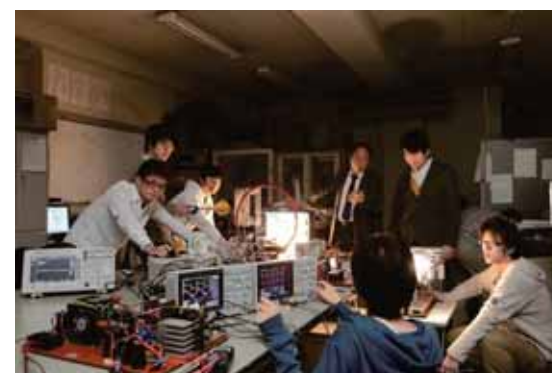

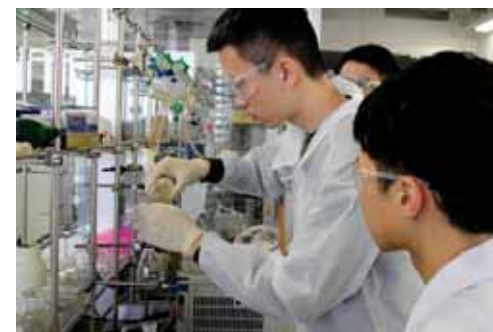

The applicant is expected to demonstrate the eligible academic/research competence to participate and contribute in the laboratory they apply for.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students who demonstrate excellent academic performance.- Students who have a clear intention to study at OIT.
Language Requirement	Japanese proficiency (at least JLPT N2 level) or English proficiency (CEFR B2 level or equivalent) required.

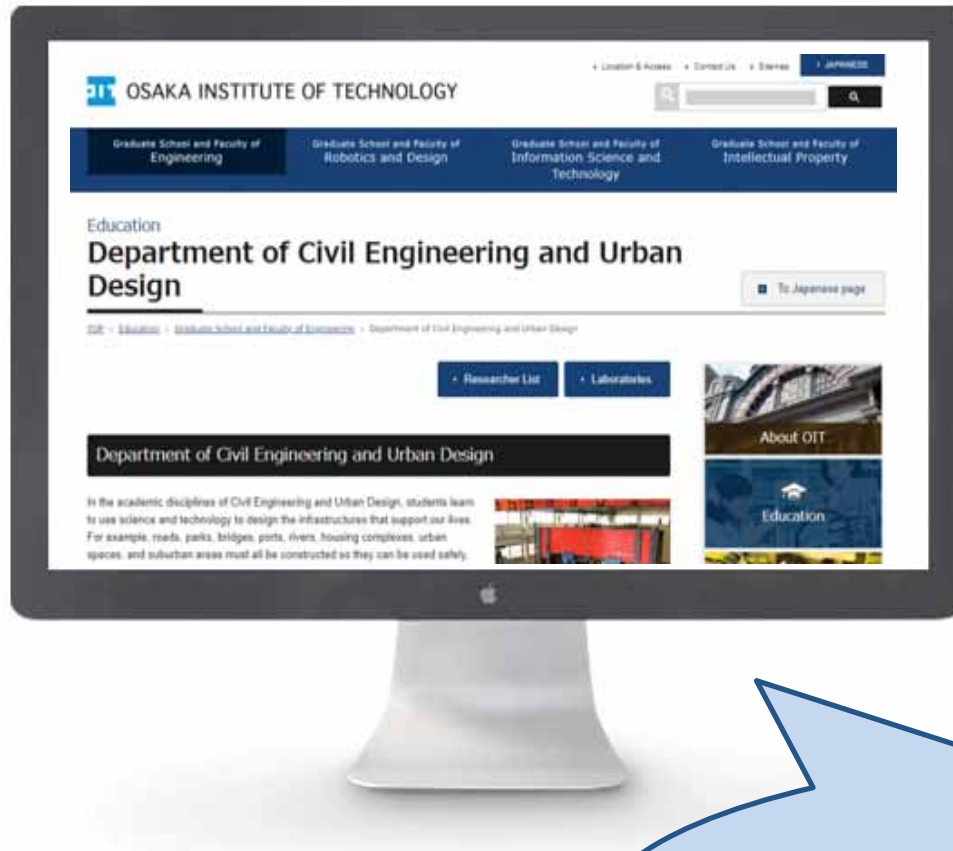

2. Proof(s) of Language Proficiency Tests such as JLPT, TOEFL, IELTS
3. Recommendation Letter from Supervisor
4. Official Certificate of Enrollment issued by the home university
5. Official Transcript of Academic Records issued by the home university
6. Photocopy of Passport (identification page)
7. ID Photograph Data (30mm×40mm, Taken within the last 3 months)

1. Basic policy of Student Mobility Program

The following three conditions must be met **by three months before your expected date of arrival in Japan**. If the situation will not get better enough by that moment, the program will be canceled.

a. International travel restrictions (all the following three) are being lifted.

- Your country allows the outbound travel to Japan and your visa can be obtained.
- Japan's borders reopen to the nationals of your country
- Japan lift quarantines for the nationals of your country.

b. Your country's safety level of the MOFA's "Overseas Travel Safety Information" is at level 1 or below (in total 4 levels, fewer level is safer).

c. The classes, practical training, laboratory work, seminars, etc. are conducted **face-to-face on campus at OIT.**

2. Policy for Student Mobility Program Spring 2022 (Updated on Oct 12, 2021)



The basic policy has not been changed. **However, we are preparing to accept students** from countries with an infectious disease risk level of 2 or higher as defined in Overseas Travel Safety Information by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan (MOFA), **provided that the following cautions are observed.**

[Cautions]

- Make sure you fully understand the entry restrictions and quarantine measures implemented by the Japanese government before applying.
- As a general rule, you will be responsible for paying for your own accommodation at a quarantine station when you enter Japan and for accommodation during the quarantine period (at least 14 days) after you are released. The university will arrange for safe and inexpensive hotel accommodations.
- If you have to wait until after April to attend school due to delays in the issuance of visas, postponement or cancel of travel, waiting in quarantine after entering the country, or closure of the university campuses due to infectious diseases, we have courses that can be taken online.
- After enrollment, please follow the instructions of the person in charge in accordance with the safety management policy of the Japanese government and the university regarding infectious disease control. Depending on the situation, entry to the campus may be suspended.
