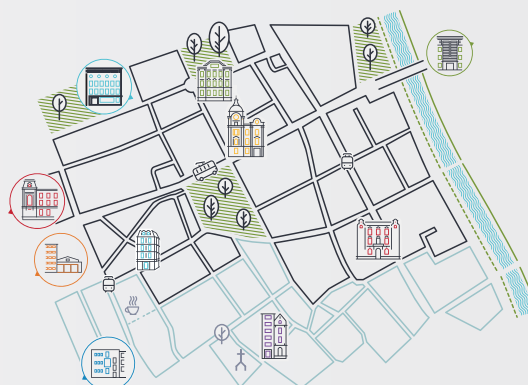

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION

- Go to the e-application website and choose “Submit application”
- For the “Faculty” field choose “REK - University of Ostrava” and below choose “Single-subject studies”
- You will now see the summer school and by clicking on the blue arrow you can continue
- Fill in your email address, choose “Continue” and “Send a login link by email”
- Go to your mail box and verify your email address by clicking on the received link
- In the next step you need to agree with the admission criteria and continue
- Fill in your personal details and “Save”, after saving you will see a summary of your application and you need to click on “Submit application”
- After submitting your application, you will see the payment details, you can pay by card, QR code or bank transfer. The safest option is to pay by card. If you choose a bank transfer, do not forget to state the specific symbol that was assigned to your individual application
- You have 14 days for the payment, unpaid applications are considered invalid
- After we receive the payment, we will contact you via email with further information
